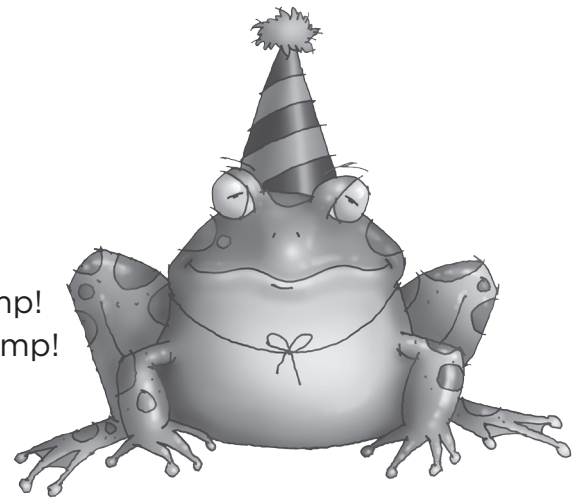
Stomp to the left, an' stomp to the right.
